Procedure

- Test each person individually, in a relatively distraction-free environment.
- Give a general explanation ("you watch a 10-sec video and answer a few questions about it"). Do not tell the participant our hypothesis.
- Randomly assign each participant to a test condition.
- Before showing the video, tell the participant the age and sex of the driver
- Show the video just once.
- Ask "How fast do you think the car was going before the accident?" (one number, in miles per hour).
- Ask "Rate how responsible you think the driver was for causing the accident?" (1-10) 1 = not at all responsible, 10 = completely responsible
- Thank the participant for helping.
- Note anything interesting or unusual in the comments section.
